## **Assembly Steps**

#### Step 1 - The Frame

Decide where your frame needs to be attached to the wall Now with help of an assistant, hold the frame to the wall Now using a spirit level, level the frame

Now mark the wall through the 4x pre-drilled frame holes

Once marked, remove the frame

Now drill wall + add raw plug + add screws

## **Step 2 - The Poster Grippers**

Each Poster Holder requires 2x Poster Grippers - see Step 2 Image Add these to the top and bottom of each Poster Holder When adding, make sure the holder gap is facing upright

## Step 3 - The U-Pockets

(If you have purchased the U-Pockets)

Sandwich 2x posters within the U-Pocket - add to Holder - See Step 3 Image Now you should have 1x U-pocket with 2x Posters with 2x Grippers

## Step 4 - Adding the Holders to the Frame

You will need a 'Phillips Screw Driver'

### (Starting at the bottom)

Lower the bottom gripper so, the metal section is protruding over the holder Now tighten this, using the 'Phillips' - do not over tighten! Now insert into your first frame hole

## (Now the top)

Present the holder to the top of the frame, calculate the gap Now loosen the top gripper, then insert in to the top frame hole Now tighten this, using the 'Phillips' - do not over tighten! Repeat Step 4 actions for all remaining / supplied Poster Holders
